1. Welcome and introductions

Introductions were made and a warm welcome given.

2. Matters arising & minutes of the last meeting

<u>Dr Mucci Talk</u> – Geoff confirmed that this is on Wednesday 17th April at 6.30pm at Sedlescombe Village Hall. Agreed to promote via the website, Facebook, Twitter, Villager and at Age Concern lunch club. Libby suggested a letter could be sent to a set age group inviting to them to attend and promoting the PPG and Age Concern who are facilitating the event. All agreed. Postage to be funded from PPG pot. ACTION: Geoff to ask Keith at Sedlescombe PPG for final content for posters and publicity.

<u>Cancer Feedback</u> – Geoff took the question about cancer raised at a previous meeting to the Hastings & Rother PPG. He is still awaiting a response and will chase.

4. AGM Planning

5. Feedback from Hastings & Rother PPG and Rural Rother PPG

No updates. Geoff couldn't attend the Hastings & Rother PPG and the Rural Rother PPG was cancelled.

6. Cutbacks on meals on wheels

John shared the recent news that East Sussex County Council has cut back funding for Meals on Wheels which will impact on patients and those attending the Age Concern lunch club who will be forced to increase their prices. He has sent a letter to Battle Observer and the Council. ACTION: Geoff to send a letter on behalf of the PPG (John to send him the information to include).

7. Practice Update

<u>Extended Access</u> – Libby shared that the surgery is opening until 8pm on Tuesdays (Oldwood), Wednesdays (Battle Health Centre) and Thursdays (Oldwood) under government directive for GPs to open late and at the weekends. Patients will be able to attend other surgeries in Rural Rother if they require an appointment on a Monday evening; or in Hastings for Friday evenings and over the weekend.

<u>Parking</u> – Libby has freed up more parking spaces in Battle through introducing parking permits and discouraging commuters. It is proving more difficult in Robertsbridge. The surgery is awaiting the impact of the parking enforcement officers in the hope that the spaces at the end of the driveway

will be available for patients to park. The Village Hall has agreed that staff can park in their car park if this doesn't work. There will be plenty of spaces in the new Health Centre once built.

8. Issues raised by patients

Libby reported back on the issues raised at the last meeting with prescriptions. The dispensary are now adding a note if a medication is not available. John & Geoff have given recent examples of errors. ACTION: Libby to look into these. David Daniels provided positive feedback about his prescriptions. All agreed overall service is good.
